This year marks the 60th anniversary for the Toys for Tots tradition of the U.S. Marine Corps Reserves. In 2006, Toys for Tots delivered more than 19.2 million toys to over 7.6 million children. In 2005, Toys for Tots delivered more than 18.5 million toys to over 7.4 million children. Unfortunately, with over 13 million children living in poverty, Toys for Tots needs your help more than ever to achieve our goal of delivering a toy to every child in need.

Toys for Tots is a 60-year tradition of the U.S. Marine Corps Reserves and is an IRS recognized 501(c)(3) not-for-profit public charity. Your cash donations will help the Marines buy toys in bulk at deeply discounted prices. These cash donations allow Toys for Tots to better ensure children receive both age and gender appropriate toys.

Donations are 100% tax deductible. Donations can be forwarded to my attention or left with the front office person at each KVHC clinic to my attention. Encourage your friends and family to support Toys for Tots.

Marine Toys for Tots deposit boxes are located at KVHC clinics in Millinocket, Island Falls, Patten and Houlton. Toys collected in each area will go to a child in that area. For instance, toys and donations collected in Patten will assist Patten area children, those collected in Millinocket will go to Millinocket area children. After the Marines and/or their representatives collect the toys and donations, Marines will purchase toys with donations, sort the toys by gender and age, call the parent(s) to select appropriate gifts for their child(ren) and ensure the children receive the gifts you donate. All toy donations should be unwrapped; however, donations of wrapping paper are also welcomed. **Deadline for collection is Friday, December 14.**
